

Highlights from our crusade in March 2025





MOVING MOUNTAINS IN NEJO

Nejo is located in the far west of Ethiopia among the mountains of the Oromia Region. The greater area has experienced much civil unrest in recent years. When we started working in the town, only around 35% of its residents were born again. Now, that number has skyrocketed! Our dedicated local team had done extensive groundwork prior to the start of the crusade, within both Nejo itself and the surrounding villages. They were incredibly active in connecting with local pastors, training believers for soul-winning and holding evangelistic outreaches. As a result, thousands had already heard the Gospel and encountered the miracle-working power of Christ, before the crusade began. By the time our international team arrived, we received the warmest of welcomes. The pastors paraded us through the streets and the people greeted us with terrific enthusiasm.















The crusade itself took place from 13–16 March. We held seven mass services over these four days upon an expansive soccer field. So many flooded the field that soon, our stage felt like an aluminium island, surrounded on all sides by tens of thousands. Preaching felt like being a spinning top—constantly turning to ensure everyone felt included. It was wonderful! In every service, multitudes called upon the Lord for salvation. Between the crusade and our pre-crusade outreaches, over 50,000 pieces of follow-up material were distributed. The pastors are jubilant and eagerly making contact with the new converts, beginning the discipleship journey.





MIGHTY MIRACLES

Prayer for the sick was quickly followed by testimony after testimony, including these that follow. Saketa is a 50-year-old farm labourer. Twenty-five years ago, a tumour developed on his stomach, growing bigger and bigger until it was a large, noticeable lump. Already a believer, he attended the crusade especially to receive prayer for healing. During one of our services, the Lord performed his own operation—and the tumour is no more! Thrilled, Saketa lifted his shirt on stage to show a perfectly flat stomach, free from any trace of the growth other than a small patch of stretched skin. "I am very, very happy!" he exclaimed.









Beshatu is also in her fifties. Unimaginably, she had suffered from an unceasing flow of blood for twenty-two years. In addition, she had endured a stroke which had incapacitated her right side. Her vision had also deteriorated. Attending our Friday afternoon service, Beshatu received prayer and our Jesus did a thorough work in her body. Since then, the bleeding has stopped completely, her right side is fully functional, and her eyesight has been restored. Elated, she beamed as she shared her story. "Thanks to the Lord Jesus Christ!" she professed. Amen and amen.

HEAPS OF HEALINGS

Dirib is an elderly farmer. For the past thirty years, he had been battling tuberculosis in his lungs and serious bladder problems. He attended one of our services and since then, all symptoms of his illnesses have vanished. Following the service, he had a vivid dream in which he heard a voice declaring his healing and felt a fire in his body. He returned to share his story. "I am completely free now," he expressed. "I am very happy!" Itenesh is a 50-year-old widow. She was diagnosed with abdominal cancer five years ago and had grown extremely ill. She needed to be carried to the crusade field, so great was the pain. After prayer, all soreness left her and strength returned.



Gete is a 35-year-old mother of five, who had been unable to move her left leg for many years. The ailment made working impossible and parenting challenging. When she heard about the crusade, she struggled to get there on her own but was determined to attend. As we prayed, she felt the power of God enter her body. Checking herself, she realised the pain had vanished and all mobility had returned. Turu is a 65-year-old widow. She had been bedridden for years, unable to move from the waist down. She attended the crusade with great difficulty but with zealous faith—and received her healing.













DYNAMIC DELIVERANCES

Gemelhis (25) came forward to testify, together with his wife. Two weeks earlier, he had been struck down by a strange disease—its main symptoms being brutal head and chest pains—that resulted in him being admitted to hospital. He was not getting any better and becoming desperate, his wife wanted to bring him to the crusade. The doctors made her sign papers saying that if he died, they could not be held responsible. Gemelhis was carried to the field, unresponsive. During prayer, the Lord touched him mightily and since then, he has made a full and speedy recovery.







Zewude is a 62-year-old woman who had been suffering the effects of witchcraft for the past six years. Her mind was tormented and her abdomen writhed with agony. At our crusade, Jesus set her free. Her thoughts are now clear and her body is liberated. An elderly farmer named Asata (65) had been suffering from severe and debilitating pain in his right side for over a year. He had visited numerous doctors, but none could determine the cause. Just that morning, he had been at the hospital, seeking help. However, after prayer, he checked himself and discovered that the pain was completely gone!









EMPOWERED & IGNITED

On the Sunday morning of our crusade week, all evangelical churches in Nejo gathered together for a combined, open-air service. We witnessed an inspiring picture of unity as a vibrant mass choir, made up of hundreds of singers from different congregations, blessed us with spirited praise and worship. We also awarded the local pastors and volunteers with certificates and Amharic copies of Ev. Tamryn Klintworth's "Spirit of Fire" book, to empower them for evangelism. In our final afternoon service, the Gospel message was followed by one last teaching on how to be a witness with signs and wonders following. We then prayed for the baptism of the Holy Spirit, leading to thousands being set ablaze to be active agents for Christ in their communities. After our service, we witnessed jubilant groups of young people, parading through the streets and singing songs of praise. God has truly touched the people of Nejo!








WOWZA 2025: DIEPSLOOT








ETHIOPIAN VILLAGE CRUSADES


